Can you describe and/or demonstrate the specific impact that TFN funding has had against your initial objectives?	<p>The Asian Women's Resource Centre (AWRC) is a specialist women's organisation providing quality assured support services to Black, Minority, Ethnic (BME) women and children who have experienced or are at risk of domestic abuse. Established in 1980 the Centre provides the provision of free advice & information, counselling, advocacy, outreach, support group sand training/workshops to women.</p> <p>AWRC's work with thousands of women and girls, addressing a wide range of forms of Violence Against Women & Girls (VAWG) and complex needs over the three decades has resulted in our developing extensive expertise, which feeds into our concurrent work in training, advising, influencing, developing policy and procedures with government, public bodies and professionals to ensure safety of women and girls.</p> <p>TFN funding supported the AWRC with core costs which enabled the organisation to sustain vital support services to women and girls experiencing abuse.</p> <p>140 women increased their income and improved their access to health and social services</p> <p>316 women developed practical skills and improved their self-esteem and confidence and become more independent</p> <p>129 women improved emotional and physical wellbeing</p>
