We were unable to work with the specific client group that we outlined in the application due to changes at Hackney Virtual School, but instead worked with care leavers (as opposed to children in care). As a result the structure of the project changed from a one-week intensive project a six-week project.
Can you describe and/or demonstrate the specific impact that TFN funding has had against your initial objectives?	We pitched for TFN funding to cover the cost of one project for 10 young people. Owing to the changes in the project structure, the funding raised from TFN did not cover the entire cost of the project, but still the vast majority! Largely due to TFN funding, we were able to run one full arts project exploring purpose, motivation and creativity with care leavers.
