Creating a dedicated fund for pro bono legal advice in environmental law for organisations in developing countries. They are seeking funds for their pro bono work that will deal with ad hoc cases in the coming year.

TFN funds supported FIELD in giving free legal advice on international environmental issues to developing country governments and public interest organisations. The funds were used in their work with small island states on climate change, and with public interest organisations on international trade. With support from TFN, FIELD worked with a group of 14 public interest organisations to draft an *amicus* brief in a WTO dispute over genetically modified (GM) products.
