Can you describe and/or demonstrate the specific impact that TFN funding has had against your initial objectives?	<p>Since being awarded the funding we have extended our clinic base from one main weekly session in SE London, Near Waterloo to a fortnightly session in the N London area of Whitechapel.</p> <p>We have been surprised by the social and more explicit poverty in N London, also the diverse cultural group that we are now reaching through the NEW Whitechapel Clinic.</p> <p>The project started later than we had planned, Sept 19', as our original site identified decided that they could not operate a clinic for Footworks</p>
What portion of the project did TFN fund?	100% We have financed the NEW clinic through funds raised during the September 18" TFN invitation.

The while TFN community have been supportive and we have had a reach out directly from one of the donors for a check- in to see how we have extended and what progress we have made.</p>
<p>Can you tell us any personal stories to highlight the value of the project?</p>	<p>We have been able to touch and treat and very diverse social group though the Whitechapel clinic; one example would be an older years Lady, lets call her Jane for the purposes of this, called Jane, she approached the service team with feet that had not been treated in years, clawed toe nails, bruised because she was only wearing slippers, she is a former sex worker who the social system and society has overlooked- a true minority group. Had it not been for our intervention she would have continued to have mobility issues that would have only worsened. She has since been signposted to other services for help and support as a result of our being in the place at the time.</p>

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
