The funding allowed us to employ a Social Worker who worked alongside our Psychologist setting up vital community projects to empower women and girls in vulnerable situations. We now work in the local primary school, secondary school and special education school in Urubamba doing weekly sex education classes, parent workshops and individual counselling along with home visits to students in high risk situations.

<p>Can you tell us any personal stories to highlight the value of the project?</p>	<p>There was a young child displaying odd behaviour in play and in the sex ed classes. After some private sessions with the social worker and psychologist we discovered they was being inappropriately touched by their brother who was going through adolescence and confused his feelings/had not received sufficient education to understand his behaviour was wrong. Both young people are now receiving support and the parents are attending workshops. Our intervention prevented what could have become much more serious abuse and led to a life time of inappropriate and harmful behaviour in the boy. We have a way to go with the case but are positive we can resolve it internally and with the schools support. Proof that sex education is needed, vital and making a difference.</p>
