The Mango Tree is an outreach programme, supporting orphans, vulnerable children and their guardians in the southern region of Kyela, where 20% of the entire population have HIV.

We're delighted to report that we achieved exactly what we said we would with TFN's wonderful May 2004 donation – and more! You funded our excellent Medical Officer, making 2,400 village visits to orphans. You put not just the planned 50, but 62 orphans into secondary school, where many of them have done exceptionally well in first year exams. And you have adopted Ngana ward, as planned, funding the uniforms and equipment to send 337 orphans to primary school there. And there was even a little left to pay for some mosquito nets! 4 trustees, 9 staff, 72 volunteers and nearly 5,000 orphans (if only they knew!) remain indebted to you all at TFN. You got us started.
