Can you describe and/or demonstrate the specific impact that TFN funding has had against your initial objectives?	<p>The hostels for boys and girls at Kwa Mkono in Tanzania have been built with bulk of the balance of the funds being made up from Polio Children.</p> <p>As I write the furniture is being made and installed for at least a 10 boys and 10 girls to start being admitted to the hostel shortly.</p> <p>Judging by the demand there will be more girls and boys admitted and as such more children will benefit then originally budgeted for. A total of upto 35 children will benefit compared to the 20 originally budgeted for and ahead of schedule. The building work was undertaken by Me Nasoro a polio victim and an alumni of the Kwa Mkono polio hostel.</p>
